A Christian religion that reintroduces the element of healing present in early Christianity.

Science

The term science is understood here in the sense of divine science or research into divine laws.

Christian

Christian Science is based exclusively on the Bible and on the teachings and work of Christ Jesus. However, it does not take into account doctrines and dogmas that arose later in church history.

An impersonal pastor, no church dignitaries

A lesson that is the same worldwide and new every week forms the basis of the Sunday sermon. This collection of quotations from the New Luther Bible and Science and Health by Mary Baker Eddy can be studied and applied individually during the week.



Quarterly

No hierarchy in the membership

Each member may be elected to any church office in turn on the basis of ability and suitability. The most important decisions are adopted by the general assembly.

Free entry and exit

Joining requires the acceptance of the

Christian Science way of life. Leaving is possible at any time without providing reasons.

Sunday Collection and Donations as a Source of Funding

The running expenses of the churches are covered by the Sunday collection, donations and grants. Only the moderate annual membership fee, democratically determined by the membership is due.

Public Sunday Services and Wednesday Testimony Meetings

The churches offer Sunday services and testimony meetings on Wednesdays. There, all participants can report physical healings, the solving of relationships, care and everyday problems through christian-scientific prayer. In Sunday School, children up to the age of 20 are introduced to the spiritual truths of the Bible and their practical application in life.

The churches also offer public lectures that demonstrate practically the application and impact of Christian Science.

Practitioners of Christian Science

Experienced Christian Scientists offer prayer support to those seeking help in solving problems in all areas of life. Authorised practitioners dedicate themselves to this task full-time.

Christian Science Nurses

Their task is to provide practical help to patients without medical aids. During their work they support healing by maintaining a healing mental atmosphere through the knowledge that God lovingly cares for all his children.

Historical review

The healings performed by Jesus and his disciples are reported in the four Gospels. The healing work of Paul and other apostles is also described in the Acts of the Apostles and letters in the New Testament.

1866: Mary suffered a serious fall on an icy road in February. The doctors treating her at the time gave her little chance of survival. When she regained consciousness, she reflected on her experiences with the Bible and the healings by Jesus described in the Gospels. Then it gradually became clear to her what the healing principle of the Messiah was based on and she was able to get up again. The doctor who was called confirmed in amazement the turnaround which led to a complete recovery.
